DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Working with the Q Loop Leadership team, serve as the liaison between faculty and the director, conducting initial meetings to get video projects started and working with faculty and the director to produce a plan for the video.

Major Duties

- Follow up on project requests
- Create initial meeting plan with faculty
- Participate in regular project design meetings with Director
- Sign and collect contract, work agreement, & model releases
- Gather information and vision for project from faculty
- Collaborate on projects with team and faculty
- Research instructional materials needed in collaboration with Director
- Organize pre-production elements and communication

HOURS:
