



Prerequisite Coursework for Admission to the MAT

Program: Physical Education Endorsement

Is a degree in Physical Education required? A future teacher must have completed the requisite coursework in Physical Education to be admitted into the MAT program at WOU. A degree in exercise science would be accepted upon review, but the coursework in Physical Education Teacher Education (PETE) would need to be completed prior to admission. A degree in any other subject would be accepted, but multiple courses in both PETE and foundational courses in movement sciences must be completed.
