Re: Graduate GPA Admission Requirement

Current GPA graduate admission requires students to have a grade point average of not less than 3.00 for the last 60 semester hours or 90 quarter hours of undergraduate work attempted in the undergraduate degree program. The Graduate Studies Committee approved adopting the following requirement: "a cumulative B average (equivalent of 3.00 on a U. S. 4.00 grading scale) on the most recent baccalaureate degree. If the applicant's cumulative GPA is below 3.00, but a calculation using the last 90-quarter credits (60 semester credits) of graded coursework is 3.00 or higher, the latter will be used as the basis for admission.

I recommend adopting the new GPA admission requirement effective July 1, 2017.
