

Prerequisite Coursework for Admission to the MAT Program: Chemistry Endorsement

Is a degree in Science required? Applicants must hold a baccalaureate degree with a major in the endorsement area (or coursework equivalent to a major in the endorsement area). Majors not aligned directly with endorsement areas will be evaluated and aligned.

The ideal candidate will have satisfied the following requirements:

- One year of General Chemistry with Lab
- One year of Organic Chemistry with Lab
- Analytical Chemistry with Lab
- Instrumental Chemistry with Lab
- Physical Chemistry
- Computer Applications in Chemistry
- Chemical Literature and Writing
- Ten upper-division Chemistry elective credits
- Math through Calculus

Are there other requirements besides coursework that need to be met, specific to your discipline? Each science endorsement area has its own requirements. Candidate's transcripts will be evaluated for a best fit if they do not hold a degree in one of the four science endorsement areas.
