 New Program Proposal Previews
 - MSEd in Educational Leadership
 - Drs Alicia Wenzel & Marie LeJeune from DEL, present a new program within the MsED program, students from Salem-Keizer, partnership, Leadership program (principle & superintendent). Courses will be online with synchronous/hybrid meetings. Courses are mapped out according to standards (NELP standard, TSPC). An overview of the coursework with credits, goals, standards was presented. Two courses (603, 635) are offered only to those with bachelor degrees.

Questions: Dave: what is the outcome for master degree holders? Answer: PCR that leads to TSPC license for administrator; Hillary asks a question about the funding model, followed Dave's question. Marie and Alicia: next step is more proposals, this is the 1st step. Create paperwork for certificates. Aim to start next summer. Dave: Who will take the courses, teachers? Timing for classes. Marie: those with initial license, late afternoons/evening for classes.

Dr. Gregory Zobel from DEL: different changes: the proposal has been previewed by both internal and external reviewers. Aim to address challenges now: shrinking program, one TT faculty, etc, with the goal to promote the program. Challenges include: name change, program simplification (for students, and marketing), Change name to "Learning Design & Technology", remove confusing current courses numbers, add some new courses, appealing names, combine some courses, some courses deletions, a list of 15 selective courses to choose from, new capstone: portfolio (90-120 hours of work). Minimum impact for Instructional Design Certificate. All the info is in the Presentation above.

Questions: Dave asks about course offering, Gz shares a detailed plan, such as course rotation, student needs, etc. Dave asks cohort, or rolling? Gz: pre-plan for things, effective student advising. Josh: Any courses offered as selective for students outside the program? Gz: Yes, multimedia is a good one, instructional design is good, grant writing.
